1 Public Performance (Demonstration) of Audiovisual Works

1.1 Movie Theatres (Cinemas)

Royalty for every single demonstration of a movie is **5%** of the receipts from ticket sales, however, no less than the following amounts:

For demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public:

50 and fewer viewers	28.46
Between 51 and 100 viewers	49.80
Between 101 and 150 viewers	71.14
Between 151 and 200 viewers	106.72
Between 201 and 250 viewers	128.06
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 14.23

For demonstration of a movie (shorter than 45 minutes) in public:

EUR

50 and fewer viewers	14.23
Between 51 and 100 viewers	28.46
Between 101 and 150 viewers	42.69
Between 151 and 200 viewers	56.91
Between 201 and 250 viewers	71.14
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 7.11

For demonstration of a cartoon in public:

EUR

50 and fewer viewers	7.11
Between 51 and 100 viewers	14.23
Between 101 and 150 viewers	21.34
Between 151 and 200 viewers	28.46
Between 201 and 250 viewers	35.57
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 4.27

(When the duration of a cartoon exceeds 45 minutes, the tariff for demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public is applied).

1.2 Film Festivals

Royalty for every single demonstration of a movie is **5%** of the receipts from ticket sales, however, no less than the following amounts:

For demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public	28.46
For demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public at children's film festivals	17.07
For demonstration of a movie (shorter than 45 minutes) in public	14.23
For demonstration of a movie (shorter than 45 minutes) in public at children's film festivals	11.38
For demonstration of a cartoon in public (when duration of a cartoon exceeds 45 minutes, the tariff for demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public is applied)	7.11
For demonstration of a cartoon in public at children's film festivals (when duration of a cartoon exceeds 45 minutes, the tariff for demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public is applied)	7.11

1.3 Diverse Events at Museums or Other Cultural Establishments

1.1.1. Permanent Showcases

Royalty per day featuring movie demonstrations during exposure of exhibition is **5%** of the receipts from ticket sales, however, no less than **EUR 14.23 per day**.

1.1.2. One-day Events, if Screen Size is below 100 cm (viewable diagonal)

Royalty for each demonstration of a program is **EUR 28.46** per single program, for program durations up to 3 hours.

When a program duration exceeds 3 hours, the royalties are calculated proportionally to program duration.

1.1.3. One-time Events, if Screen Size is above 100 cm (viewable diagonal)

Royalties for every single demonstration of a movie.

For demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public:**EUR**

50 and fewer viewers	28.46
Between 51 and 100 viewers	49.80
Between 101 and 150 viewers	71.14
Between 151 and 200 viewers	106.72
Between 201 and 250 viewers	128.06
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 14.23

For demonstration of a movie (shorter than 45 minutes) in public:**EUR**

50 and fewer viewers	14.23
Between 51 and 100 viewers	28.46
Between 101 and 150 viewers	42.69
Between 151 and 200 viewers	56.91
Between 201 and 250 viewers	71.14
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 7.11

For demonstration of a cartoon in public:**EUR**

50 and fewer viewers	7.11
Between 51 and 100 viewers	14.23
Between 101 and 150 viewers	21.34
Between 151 and 200 viewers	28.46
Between 201 and 250 viewers	35.57
Above 250 viewers, for each segment of additional 50 viewers	+ 4.27

(When the duration of a movie exceeds 45 minutes, the tariff for demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public is applied).

1.1.4. Use of Film Fragments in Educational Programs of Museums

When the total duration of film excerpts does not exceed 5 minutes (per lecture), the royalty for use of film fragments incorporated in educational programs of museums is **EUR 2,13** per educational lecture. The addendum per extra segment of 5 minutes is **EUR 2,13**.

Minimum licence fee is EUR 17,07 per annum.

1.2. Concerts, Balls and Other Events where Licenses for Public Performance of Music are Obtained

Royalty per single demonstration of a movie is:

	EUR
Per segment of 250 visitors per demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer)	42.69
Per segment of 250 visitors per demonstration of a movie (shorter than 45 minutes)	21.34
Per segment of 250 visitors per demonstration of a cartoon (when the duration of a cartoon exceeds 45 minutes, the tariff for demonstration of a movie (duration 45 minutes or longer) in public is applied)	14.23

When the number of visitors exceeds 250, the royalties are calculated proportionally to the size of the audience.

1.3. Public Performance of an Audiovisual Work Incorporated into a Stage Performance

Royalty per demonstration of a film or its fragment (per performance) is:

	EUR
For the first minute of an audiovisual work	8.54
For the second minute of the audiovisual work	7.11
For the third minute of the audiovisual work	5.69
Per minute, starting with the fourth minute and further on	4.27

2 Public Performance of Music of Audiovisual Works (Film Music) and Concert Transmission

2.1 Public performance of films with entrance fee

Royalties for public performance of musical works via film demonstration:

1% of entrance fee gross receipts.

Minimum royalties: **EUR 4,27** per film per quarter.

Minimum royalties: **EUR 2,13** per short film and animation(up to 40min) per quarter.

Minimum licence fee is **EUR 14,23**.

2.2 Public performance of films without entrance fee (cinemas, events etc)

Royalties for public performance of a full-length film:

EUR **14,23** if audience is up to 100 people

EUR **28,46** if audience is from 101 to 300 people

EUR **42,69** if audience is from 301 to 500 people

EUR **56,91** if audience is larger than 500 people

Royalties for public performance of a short film or an animation (up to 40 min):

EUR **4,27** if audience is up to 100 people

EUR **7,83** if audience is from 101 to 300 people

EUR **10,67** if audience is from 301 to 500 people

EUR **14,23** if audience is larger than 500 people

Minimum licence fee is **EUR 14,23**.

2.3 Concert retransmission

Royalties for public performance of musical works via concert retransmission:

4% of entrance fee gross receipts.

Minimum royalty: **EUR 14,23** per concert.

For the usage of music in public performance in cinema's foyer during the intervals between shows tariff for shops is applied.

2.4 Film lectures

1% of entrance fee gross receipts.

Up to 2 lectures minimum royalty **EUR 14,23**, per each additional lecture **EUR 5,69**.
